Note: The club reserves the right to transfer machines into suitable classes to maintain the spirit of the competition.
- Riders:** It is the rider's responsibility to ensure that your bike, helmet and clothing conform to the Road Traffic Act.
- Awards:** All finishers will receive points towards the Northern British Bike Championship. All riders that complete all rounds will also receive an award
The Barrie Rodgers Trophy will be awarded for the best performance by a Classic Club member (The trophy to be awarded annually and held for 1 year)

First riders start at 10.00am then at 1 minute intervals, in pairs.
- Course:** One Lap of approx. 30 miles with approx. 30 sections. There will be alternative routes for clubmen.

Marking Scoring system 0-1-2-3-5 & special test to resolve any ties. Machines must **Maintain a Forward** motion and will be deemed to be in the section when the front wheel passes the begins card until the **Front Wheel** passes the end cards.
